How to reach Hohenkammer

1) Arrival by car:

You will come most probably via the Autobahn E 45/ A 9 Muenchen-Nuernberg. Take exit 67 „Allershausen/ Freising/ Hohenkammer“ and drive 5 km direction Hohenkammer. In the center of the village turn right, go several meters downhill and then turn left direction Petershausen. The castle is visible from there, after several more meters, you turn right into Schloss-Strasse and cross the bridge.

2) Arrival by plane:

The best way from the airport is definitely by taxi to Schloss Hohenkammer (ca. 25 km).

3) Arrival by train:

At Muenchen-Hauptbahnhof, you go from the main platform downstairs to the S-Bahn. On your way, you will pass a ticket counter. There you buy a „Grosse Streifenkarte“ for 10.50 Euro. The ticket shows 10 stripes, you have to stamp stripe 1-6 in the little blue slot machine at the entrance. If you do not get it at the counter, it is a little bit more difficult: 1., Find the ticket machine. 2., Find the button „Grosse Streifenkarte“ and press it. 3., The price „10.50“ is indicated. 4., Insert a 10 Euro note and a 50 cent coin. Alternatively, you can use 2 and 1 Euro coins. 5., Your ticket is then printed and thrown out together with your change. 6., Stamp 6 stripes in the slot machine. All S-Bahn trains at Hauptbahnhof use the same platform. You take the „S2“ (northbound) to „Petershausen“. It takes ca. 30 minutes. At Petershausen, it looks pretty lonesome on Sundays. Go through the tunnel to the ugly old green station building. From there, you call either my mobile phone (**0175-5825-333**) or the Reception at Schloss Hohenkammer (08137- **9340**). They will forward your message to us and we will pick you up in front of the station building after 10 minutes.

Officially, lunch buffet is from 18.00-20.30. However, people arriving later do not have to starve because there is the nice restaurant of the castle.
